美國南伊利諾大學來訪貴賓 深化國際交流與合作

2月29日本校隆重迎接來自美國南伊利諾大學 Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (SIUE) 的貴賓，包括該校國際合作與研究生國際招生主任 Dr. James Monahan、國際事務學生顧問 Ms. Joanna Ford，以及橄欖枝國際教育服務機構總裁 Marc Chang。在校史館與校園進行導覽後，由陳慶和校長、劉遠楨副校長、陳永倉主任秘書、蔡葉榮學務長、周淑卿教務長、楊啟文總務長、師資培育處陳錦芬處長、研發處國際組林盈好組長、華語文中心周美慧主任等師長親自接待，進行國際交流合作會談。

會談伊始，陳慶和校長致詞表達對於未來合作的熱切期待。隨後，國際組林盈好組長向貴賓介紹本校在國際化方面的成就與進展，包括遍布全球各地的姊妹校、與美國 Stockton University 和 Appalachian State University 簽訂

的合作備忘錄、成果優異的姊妹校語言文化研習團活動、與 Fulbright 的學術合作成果、雙聯學位計畫、海外教學實習計畫、交換生至國北教大附小見習的豐碩成果，以及國際生教學助理和工作坊的推行成效。

接著，華語文中心周美慧主任介紹中心推廣華語教育的成果，包含文化課程與正在進行的優化華語計畫。Dr. James Monahan 則分享了 SIUE 位於聖路易斯大都會區的地理優勢、該校在全國博士院校排名前 30%、美國頂尖商學院之一的地位，以及其在高等教育多元化卓越獎方面的傑出成就，涵蓋商業、教育、科學與工程等領域的學術研究單位。

透過這次會談，我們期待能夠與 SIUE 建立合作夥伴關係，特別是在教師交流和學術交流等方面，能為本校學生開闢更加廣闊的國際學習機會，從而促進學術交流與文化互鑑。

NTUE Welcomes SIUE Delegates: International Collaboration

On February 29th, we warmly welcomed esteemed guests from Southern Illinois University Edwardsville (SIUE), including Dr. James Monahan, Director of International Partnership and Graduate and International Admissions, Ms. Joanna Ford, Program and Student Advisor of International Affairs, and Mr. Marc Chang, President of Olive Branch International Education Services. Following a guided tour of the Gallery of NTUE History and the campus, the guests were personally received by President Dr. Ching-Ho Chen, Vice President Dr. Yuan-Chen Liu, Secretary-General Mr. Tsang Chen, Dean of Student Affairs Office Dr. Yeh-Jung Tsai, Dean of Academic Affairs Office Dr. Shu-Ching Chou, Dean of General Affairs Office Dr. Chi-Wen Yang, Dean of Teacher Education Office Dr. Chin-Fen Chen, Director of the International Affairs Office Dr. Tiffany Lin, and Director of the Chinese Language Education Center Dr. Mei-Hui Chou for a discussion on international collaboration and exchange.

The meeting began with an address by President Dr. Ching-Ho Chen, expressing eagerness for future collaboration. Following that, Dr. Tiffany Lin, Director of the International Affairs Office, presented our university's achievements in internationalization, including partnerships with sister schools worldwide, MOUs with Stockton University and Appalachian State University, the successful Language and Cultural

Program for Partner Schools, academic cooperation with Fulbright, dual degree programs, overseas teaching practicum outcomes, exchange student practicum experiences at National Taipei University of Education Experimental Elementary School, and the achievements of international student teaching assistants and workshops.

Dr. Mei-Hui Chou, Director of the Chinese Language Education Center, further outlined the center's successes in promoting Chinese language education, including various cultural courses and the ongoing Mandarin Excellence Program. Dr. James Monahan shared SIUE's geographical advantages being located in the metropolitan St. Louis area, its ranking in the top 30% of doctoral institutions nationally, its status as one of the top business schools in the USA, and its receipt of the Higher Education Excellence in Diversity Award, among other accomplishments across business, education, science, and engineering academic units.

Through this cooperation meeting, we look forward to establishing a partnership with SIUE, particularly in areas such as faculty exchange and academic exchanges, to provide our students with broader international learning opportunities, thereby enhancing academic exchanges and cultural understanding.
