Course plan

1. Individuals or groups, ranging from ages over 18.
2. Students will be divided into classes according to their Mandarin proficiency; no experience is also acceptable.
3. The program includes 12 Mandarin classes, 3 culture classes, 2 Chinese talk activities, and 3 Field trips.
4. Students can choose up to 3 Culture Classes to join in. (Early Bird Special: 4 Culture Classes.) Class will only be held with a minimum of 6 applicants, please arrange these culture classes based on applicant's priorities. If students wish to join more classes, it costs NT\$500 per class.

Important Notice

1. CLEC reserves the rights to change the courses accordingly.
2. The program will only be held with a minimum of 20 applicants. Once the quota has been filled, CLEC will stop accepting applications and make an announcement on the website without further individual notice. CLEC will inform the participant whether the class will be held and send the payment notice before 2020/03/31.
3. The University provides NT\$1,000,000 in Accidental Injury Insurance coverage, as well as NT\$100,000 in Accidental Medical Insurance coverage for each participant in the program. Participants are advised to arrange additional medical, travel and other relevant insurance coverage before departure to Taiwan.

1. Price per session:

NT\$28,000

2. Notice: The price of each session includes

- (1) Textbooks, materials expense, and insurance
- (2) Transportation costs, entrance fees, meal expenses during field trips.
- (3) Early Bird: From now until March 16th 2020
- (4) During the program, each participant will be insured NT\$1,000,000 of accident injury insurance and NT\$100,000 of accidental medical insurance.

3. Refund policy:

- (1) Ask for refund before the program opening day, 90% of the fee will be refunded. Processing fee will not be refunded.
- (2) Ask for refund within the first 1/3 of camp days, 50% of the fee will be refunded. Processing fee will not be refunded.
- (3) All refunds will be paid via bank transfer. Processing time is around 10 working days.
- (4) During the program, if there is a typhoon, earthquake or other unavoidable natural causes, and the Taipei municipal government have announced that classes will be cancelled that day, all activities and classes for summer camp will automatically be cancelled. There will be no make-up classes, or refund for the cancelled classes.

4. Accommodation:

Students need to arrange the accommodation on their own.
