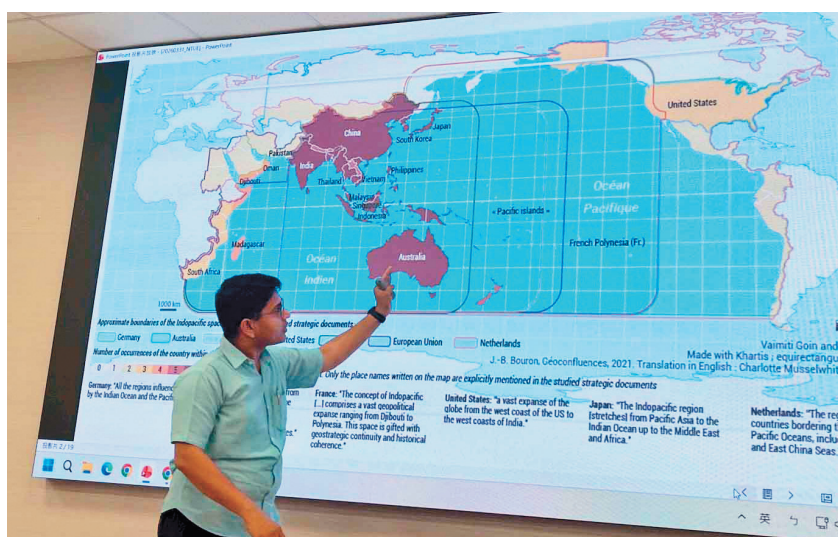

The Office of International Affairs at National Taipei University of Education (NTUE) hosted its first International Peace Lecture, titled “Peace, Cooperation, and Competition in the Indo-Pacific,” on March 31, 2026. The event featured Professor Manoj Kumar Panigrahi of the Jindal School of International Affairs at O.P. Jindal Global University, who is also a 2026 MOFA Fellowship Visiting Scholar at National Chengchi University. The lecture attracted enthusiastic participation from both students and faculty, creating a vibrant atmosphere for academic exchange and dialogue.

Delivered in an accessible, introductory format, Professor Panigrahi actively engaged the audience through a series of thought-provoking questions designed to encourage deeper reflection on contemporary international issues. By fostering discussion and critical thinking, he guided participants in examining the evolving dynamics of the Indo-Pacific region, including themes of peacebuilding, regional cooperation, and strategic competition, while also considering their broader implications for global stability. This interactive approach helped cultivate dialogue, collaboration, and a more nuanced understanding of the complexities shaping today’s international landscape.

The event provided participants with a valuable opportunity to deepen their understanding of international relations and global governance. Through engaging discussions and interactive exchanges, attendees gained diverse perspectives on pressing global issues while further enhancing their awareness of the Indo-Pacific’s strategic significance. In addition, the speaker also introduced O.P. Jindal Global University, a leading private university in India, highlighting its strong academic reputation, interdisciplinary approach, and commitment to excellence in higher education. He also shared insights into the university’s diverse academic programs, internationally oriented curriculum, and emphasis on fostering global engagement and cross-cultural understanding, offering the audience a broader perspective on higher education in a global context.

國立臺北教育大學（NTUE）國際事務處於 2026 年 3 月 31 日舉辦本學期首場國際和平講座，主題為「印太地區的和平、合作與競爭」。本次活動邀請印度 O.P. Jindal Global University 國際事務學院 Manoj Kumar Panigrahi 教授擔任主講人，同時亦為國立政治大學 2026 年外交部獎學金訪問學者。活動吸引眾多師生踴躍參與，現場氣氛熱絡，展現豐富的學術交流能量。
